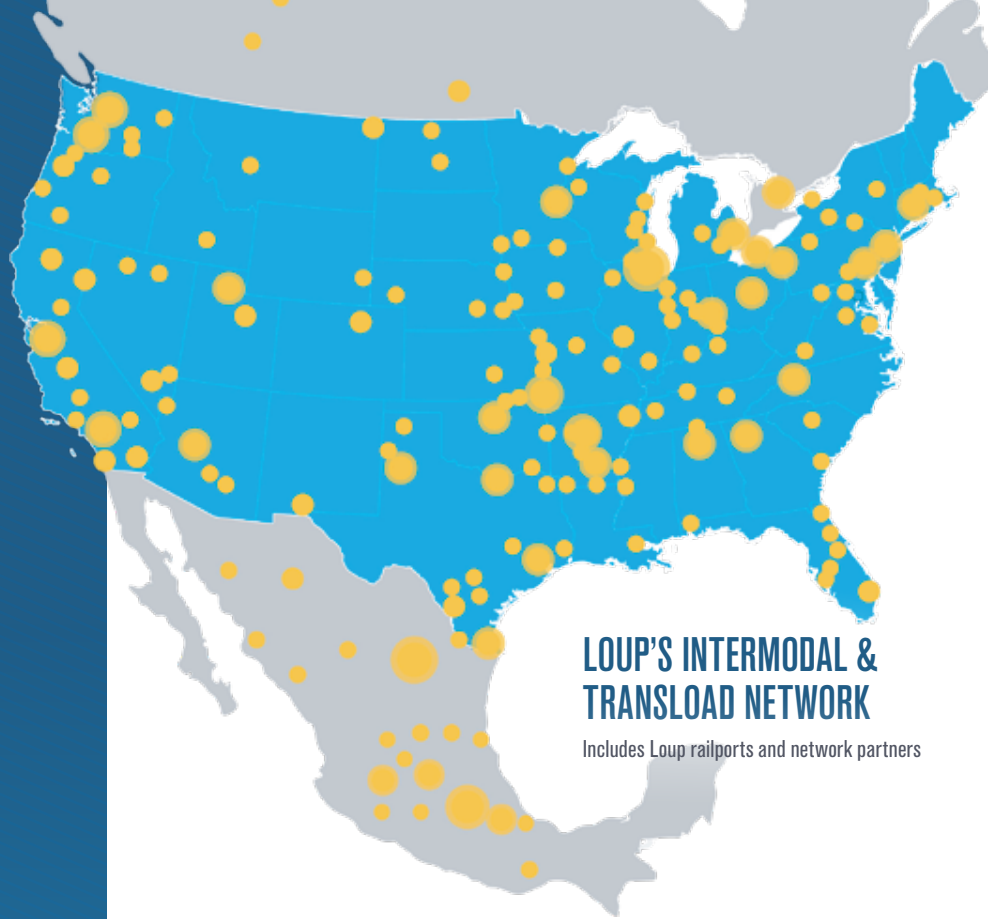

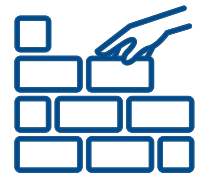

At Loup, our goal is to help employees develop skill sets enabling them to grow, develop in new positions across the company and become experts in their roles. DRIVING SUSTAINABLE SOLUTIONS

With Loup's parent company, Union Pacific's improved service product and commitment to improving the customer experience positions it as the transportation provider of choice for its customers. Our goal is to capitalize on the many advantages that rail transportation can offer and grow our traffic over less-efficient forms of transportation. Rail remains the most fuel-efficient way to move freight over land by cutting greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by up to 75% compared to commercial trucks. Our value proposition creates economic strength and supports profitable and responsible growth, allowing us to invest more in our future. We are positioned to support the transition to a low-carbon economy through the shipment of sustainable recyclable goods as those markets grow.



CHAMPIONING ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

As a wholly owned subsidiary, we know that railroads are one of the most fuel-efficient means of transporting freight by land. However, we know that there are still actions railroads must take to reduce their carbon footprint. In early 2021, the Science Based Targets Initiative approved our targets to reduce absolute scope 1 and 2 and locomotive welltowheel GHG emissions from our operations 26% by 2030 against a 2018 baseline. We believe this is an important step to understanding how much and how quickly we need to reduce our emissions, as well as anticipate future policies and regulations.



STRENGTHENING OUR COMMUNITIES

Loup is dedicated to serving and investing in communities, improving the quality of life where our employees live and work. Loup and Union Pacific's capital investments create economic opportunity through employment and supply chain activity and represent investments in building a rail network that supports sustainable economic growth for generations to come. Loup is committed to facilitating over-the-road conversions to move product on rail; if a transload solution does not exist within a given market, Loup will create one.

TRUCKING SERVICES

Loup and our partners own truck fleets at select transload facility locations and/or partner with 3rd party providers to facilitate origin and destination trucking services in conjunction with transloading services.

SPECIALIZED SERVICES

Loup and its transload partners provide specialized services onsite at transload facilities. The types of specialized services vary by commodity from lumber trimming to pipe fitting, re-packaging, palletizing, etc. Loup will explore expanding its offerings to meet our customers needs, no matter what the request.

Warehousing and storage services provide a supply chain extension to meet JIT inventory demands. Loup and its transload partners invest in equipment, land, track and inventory systems to support the movement of product between truck and rail. Loup is committed to facilitating over-the-road conversions to move product on rail; if a transload, warehousing or storage solution does not exist within a given market, Loup will create one.
