

Ramp Change: Northern California to/from Midwest Destinations

On January 8, 2020, the Union Pacific Premium Team issued an announcement stating that, effective January 27, 2020, domestic intermodal business ingating or outgating in Northern California moving between: Kansas City, Missouri; St. Louis, Missouri (Dupo terminal); Marion, Arkansas and Memphis, Tennessee (interchange) will transition from the Oakland ramp to the Lathrop ramp. Interchange destinations via Memphis, Tennessee, on CSXT include: Central Florida ILC; Charlotte, North Carolina; Fairburn, Georgia and Jacksonville, Florida. The last day to ingate equipment at Oakland for these destinations is Saturday, January 25 by 12:00 PST. The last day to waybill and ingate domestic traffic at Kansas City, St. Louis and Marion for Oakland destination is January 21 by 14:00 CST. All waybills and ingates thereafter must reflect Lathrop destination.

In addition, international intermodal service from Oakland, California to Kansas City, Missouri; St. Louis, Missouri (Dupo terminal) and Marion, Arkansas will no longer be available effective January 27, 2020. The last day to ingate international equipment for these lanes is Saturday, January 25 by 12:00 PST. Please note that westbound international service from Kansas City, St. Louis and Marion to Oakland remains unchanged. Intermodal schedules at up.com will be updated by the end of the week, allowing customers to plan gate cutoff times as well as service frequency. View the full announcement <u>here</u>.
